I am requesting funding for the Municipality of Camuy's Postal Infrastructure Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Municipality of Camuy, located at Ave. Muñoz Rivera 116 Camuy PR 00627. The funding will create a standardized, field-based system for naming streets and numbering structures through on-site mapping and documentation to improve address accuracy, municipal planning, and organized community development.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it establishes a standardized addressing system that improves emergency response times, strengthens public safety and service delivery, enhances infrastructure planning and interagency coordination, and provides lasting benefits for municipal governance and disaster preparedness.
